On behalf of the Chair of the Smart Partnership Movement, His Excellency Yoweri Kaguta Museveni, President of Uganda; CPTM Fellow & Companion, we hope you will be participating in the Annual Smart Partnership Dialogue. As promised in February, when we announced the dates of 19<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> June 2011, confirmed by the Host Patron & Adviser, Hon Dato' Sri Mohd Najib bin Tun Haji Abdul Razak, Prime Minister of Malaysia, we now have the pleasure to inform you further about the **Administrative Arrangements, including the Tentative Programme**, as outlined online by the Malaysian Foreign Affairs, launched on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> April. Background on **CPTM Smart Partnership Dialogues' Way Forwards and Framework for Implementation** since 2009 are included in the CPTM website.

### Smart Partners' Inclusion Initiatives & lessons from "1 Malaysia"

2. As you will observe the Tentative Programme offers a potential unique exposure to the current Malaysian implementation of their Vision 2020, under the aegis of **1Malaysia & Government Transformation Programmes**. Over the years, and since LID '07 – at the Global Dialogues 2008 (SAID Zambia), 2009 (EAID Uganda) and many other Smart Partners' interactions from Eastern, Western, Southern Africa to the Caribbean and the Mediterranean, the **Smart Partnership practice** has been **applied to**, and - what matters more – **integrated into National Visions**, in many countries of the Movement, in the Commonwealth and beyond. In various Regional Webs Initiatives, even in the absence of a Global Dialogue in 2010, the Smart Partners anticipated that Global 2011 (LID) will acknowledge and take forward their own regional and national initiatives, and embody them in the Global 2011(LID) Way Forward, towards a Global 2012 in Southern Africa.

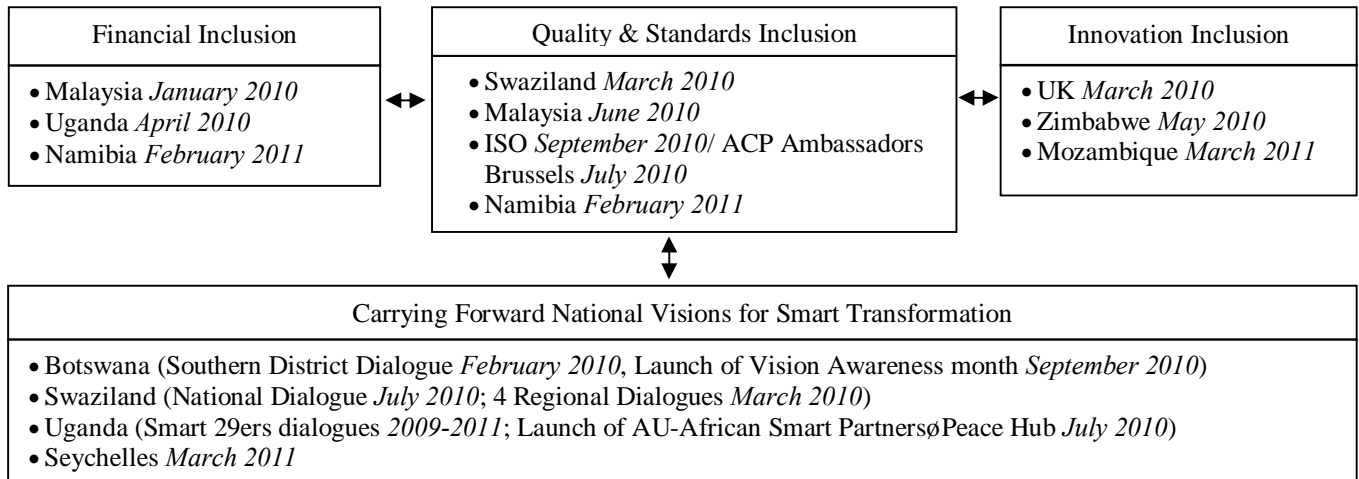

### High Points and Highlights of Smart Partners' in-country experiences

3. Beyond these exciting initiatives, the **Smart Partnership Dialogues** became the **hallmark** for approaching the broad range of **current geopolitical / economic / social / technological developments**. The Movement's **integrated** and **'smart approach'**, as illustrated in all these Initiatives on **instruments for transformation**, realises the full potential of the **Smart Links**, when brought together in a complementary **"win-win-win"** manner. You may wish to note, the enclosed reminder, **which evokes High points and Highlights** of some of the **recent Smart Partners in-country experiences**, and which have received welcome support from Governments and Private Sector concerned, since Global 2009.



4. The Annual Global "get-together" gives unique scope **to celebrate and to communicate in a Smart Partnership Way the real-time experiences**, which the Movement has pioneered in the last 15 years. As the Movement evolved impetus for change, which has sprung out of the Smart Partnership Movement in the most recent years, it needs to find its expression in the build up, towards global 2011 (LID), intellectually and practically, as well as, of course, in the dialoguing process itself. **Year in year out this has been our challenge, to our Movement as a whole, and our Dialogues' Hosts**. The Movement, through CPTM, has deliberately shared its real-time experiences from the Annual Dialogues with each other and with every Commonwealth country, in what we consider to be a typical Smart Partnership Way.

5. The CPTM Smart Partnership Movement is led by Heads of State/Government (Council of Patrons & Advisers), as well as **Smart Partners Links (Business, Fellows, Civil Servants, Politicians, Labour, Social Issues, Media, Art & Culture, Smart 29ers)**. We have been inspired by the motivation, driven by Smart Partnership and mobilisation, and the capacity of the **young Smart 29ers**, each working within their own national context smartly synchronising with each other globally, particularly in Uganda, Botswana, Seychelles, Mozambique, Swaziland, Lesotho, Namibia and Malaysia.

6. Since 1995, the Annual Smart Partnership Dialogues have played a unique role in channeling the energies and real-time wisdom of all those, who believe in and contribute to the Smart Partnership Movement in Malaysia, Southern Africa, East Africa, Caribbean, West Mediterranean, as well as in the Commonwealth and beyond. You might also wish to note the extracts from **Chairman's address at the 15/25 years' anniversary**.

8. The agenda of LID 2011 will showcase Malaysian achievements in transforming and realizing its national Vision 2020 through: 1Malaysia : People First, Performance Now; Government Transformation Programme (GTP); Economic Transformation Programme (ETP); and New Economic Model (NEM)

The Malaysia economic transformation programme will be further **shared with participants** through parallel field sessions focusing on Transitioning from Agriculture to Agri-business; Competitiveness in Manufacturing; Promoting ICT Enterprises; Nurturing SME start-ups in biotechnology; Climate Change & Sustainable Development.

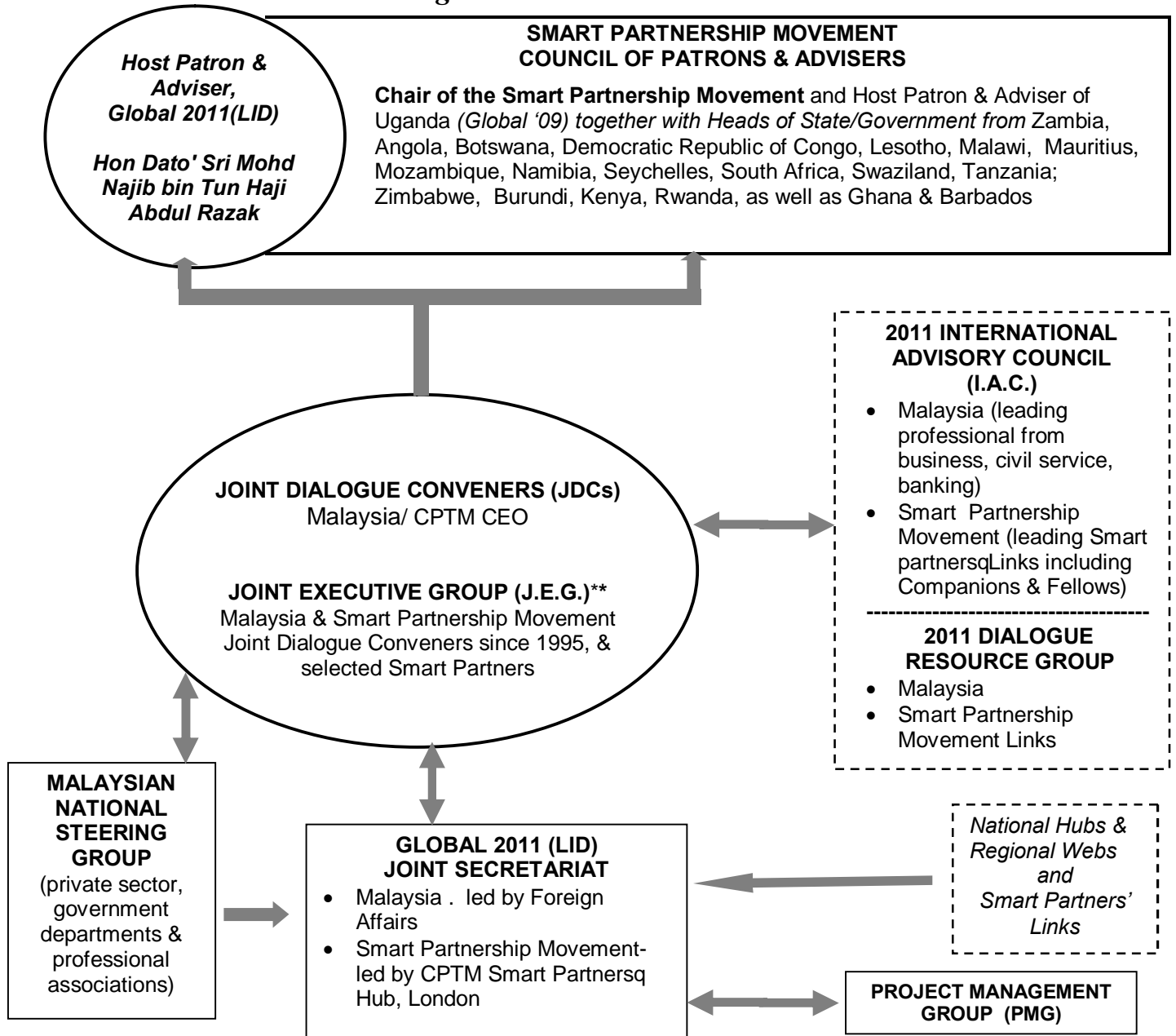
